- VENUE Entrance Requirements:** **ALL Adults must have Picture ID (Valid Drivers License or Passport). The driver will need to show a valid driver's license, current vehicle registration, and proof of insurance at the Gate. For expedited access to Ft. - COMPETITION:** **Official Qualifier Event for Junior Olympics & U.S. National Championships**
- COMPETITION FEES:**
- 1) Sparring, Poomsae (Forms), & Competition Poomsae (Forms) \$70 for one event & \$20 for each additional event.
  - 2) Coach Pass \$30
  - 3) The MSTTA has waived all late fees.
  - 4) Online Registration will be cutoff at 1:59 am EST Sun. February 5, 2012.

- COACHING:** Coaches are not required to hold Associate Coach (AC), Level1 or higher to coach at a State Championship this year but are **required to be members of USAT**. Coach Passes are \$30 which can be purchased through USAT at [www.usat.hangastar.com](http://www.usat.hangastar.com). Online registration will be cutoff at 1:59 am EST Sun. 2/05/12. Coach Passes **can not** be purchased on site.
- COMPETITION RULES:** The current USAT & Modified WTF competition rules will govern this championship.
- WEIGH-IN:** Weigh-In is required for all belts & all ages, except those who are only competing in "Poomsae", on Friday 2/10/12 at the venue, 6-10 PM.
- MANDATORY EQUIPMENT:** WTF approved white v-neck uniform only (no color trim except on black belt v-neck). All Sparring competitors must wear (WTF approved): white, red or blue headgear (red & blue headgear must be matched with chest protector color) and, red and blue reversible chest protector, forearm guard, shin and instep guard, groin cup (male only, worn inside) and mouthpiece. Each competitor must provide his or her own equipment. Some equipment will be sold at the tournament site.  
**Important Note:** Competitors must wear USAT recognized belt colors (**Yellow, Green, Blue, Red, & Black**) during the competition. Belt colors such as Orange, Purple, or Brown are **not allowed**.

## U.S. National Championships & Junior Olympics

### QUALIFICATIONS GUIDELINE

#### 2012 Qualification:

**Requirements:** The 2012 Maryland East Coast Qualifier is a direct qualifier for the USAT U.S. National Championships and Junior Olympics. To compete in this competition all competitors' must be USAT members. Review Attachment A for which divisions, competitors are required to be a U.S. Citizen or Resident. Proof of U.S. Citizenship is only valid with a U.S. birth certificate or U.S. passport. Social Security Cards are **NOT** proof of citizenship, but are proof of residency. If the individual is not a valid resident or U.S. citizen he/she WILL NOT be able to compete at the Junior Olympics or Senior Nationals.

**Note:** The 2012 Maryland East Coast Qualifier is open for all states.

#### Sparring

All categories must be the same age, belt and weight as the USAT National Qualifiers, Junior Olympics and U.S. National Championships. (Please see Attachment A for a list of all categories).

**Color Belts:** **6+ year olds** – All participants will qualify for the 2012 Junior Olympics and/or National Championships if they participate in a sanctioned 2012 State Championship.

**Black Belts:** **6-9 and 33+ year olds** -- All participants will qualify for the 2012 Junior Olympics and/or National Championships if they compete in a sanctioned 2012 State Championship.

**10-32 year olds** – The top four finalists will qualify for World Class sparring divisions.

1. Athletes must compete in the age category according to what age they will be as of December 31, 2012.
2. If an athlete in the 14-17 BB or 18-32 BB divisions qualifies at a National Qualifier, they are then excluded from qualifying in that same division at a subsequent State Championships.
3. A person may NOT qualify in the same world class division in multiple states; this action will jeopardize the person's qualification.
4. *If a competitor wants to compete in both the Junior Olympics 14-17 Black Belt Division and the Senior Black Belt Division, he/she must compete and qualify in each division.*

---

#### Poomsae (Forms):

All categories must be the same age and belt as the USAT National Qualifiers, Junior Olympics and U.S. National Championships. (Please see Attachment A for a list of all categories).

1. All individuals participating in a state championship **will advance to the Junior Olympics and U.S. National Championships in Dallas, TX.**
  - a. **14-99 year old black belts** – The top 3 finalists will qualify for World Class Poomsae divisions.
2. **2012 U.S. National Poomsae Team Trials** -- The top 3 finalists in all State Championships will qualify for the 2012 U.S. National Poomsae team trials. The Team Trials date and location are TBD.

**Important Note:** Competitors must wear USAT recognized belt colors (**Yellow, Green, Blue, Red, & Black**) during the competition. Belt colors such as Orange, Purple, or Brown **are not allowed**.

**POOMSAE:** Poomsae competitors must perform only the Poomsae designated for their specific rank. Scores will be based on: proper order, beauty, grace, rhythm, accuracy, power, technique and attitude. Authorized Poomsae are those approved by the WTF (see above). All competitors competing in the Dragon, Ninjas, or Youth & All color belt divisions will only be required to perform their respective poomsae for their Rank. This competition will be Single elimination like sparring.

**SPARRING:** The current [USAT & Modified WTF competition rules](#) will govern this championship.

### Junior Sparring Safety Rules

#### 1. No Head Contact

##### a. Ages 7 & Under (All Belts) and Ages 11 & Under (Color Belt Divisions)

##### i. In National Qualifier and National Junior Olympic Championships sparring competition, the rules concerning a kick to the face shall be as follows:

1. Any technique contacted to the head area which does not cause any injury, will be given a warning by the referee ("Kyong-go").
2. Any technique, which causes injury to the head area will result in a one-point deduction by the referee ("Gam-jeom").
3. If the competitor cannot continue because of the injury to the head area, the attacker will be disqualified.

NOTE: Inability to continue because of fright, crying or loss of will following a kick to the head which did not cause injury does not constitute grounds for disqualification of the attacker.

#### 2. Junior Safety Rules

##### a. Ages 8-11 (Black Belts), 12-13 Year Old Divisions (All Belts), and 14-17 Year Old Divisions (Color Belts)

##### i. In National Qualifier and National Junior Olympic Championships sparring competition, the rules concerning a kick to the face shall be as follows:

1. The competitor is allowed to kick to the facial area; however, the kick must be light contact with appropriate control without causing any injury or excessive contact, or the appropriate penalty shall be invoked.
2. The competitor who executes a successful technique (light contact without causing any injury) shall be awarded three (3) points.
3. The competitor who executes a kick to the face which results in a minor injury shall receive a one-point ("Gam-jeom") deduction. A minor injury is defined as abrasion or bleeding caused by nonexcessive contact. The referee, with or without consultation with the tournament physician, shall determine if the abrasion or bleeding is a minor injury, and if the attack is a non-excessive one.
4. The competitor who executes a kick to the face which results in the inability of the opponent to continue sparring because of injury shall be disqualified. The referee, with or without consultation with the tournament physician, shall determine if the attack is an excessive contact, and if the injury is a major one.

NOTE: Inability to continue because of fright, crying or loss of will following a legal kick to the head which did not cause injury does not constitute grounds for disqualification of the attacker.

#### 3. 14-17 Year Old Black Belts and Senior Division (All Belts)

##### a. In National Qualifiers, Junior Olympic Championships, and Senior National Championship sparring competition, the Senior Black Belt adult rules shall apply for these divisions.

#### Excessive contact to the facial or head area:

Even in the absence of visible injury, such as slight bleeding or abrasion, the referee may deem the contact to be excessive, and declare the appropriate penalty.

1) Where Junior Competition Rules are in effect per Article 2 above, the competitor who executes a successful technique to the face (light, controlled contact without causing any injury) shall be awarded three points. This is to better align with current WTF standards; however, the criteria for "excessive contact" will continue to be strictly enforced.

2) 8-Count - Under Junior Competition Rules, the referee should NOT give an 8-count for ANY technique, even a legal one, to the head area; if a kick to the head is powerful enough to warrant an 8-count, it should be considered excessive, and the appropriate penalty should be declared. However, the referee can and should begin an 8-count for a legal kick to the trunk area that results in a knock-down condition.

3) Turning Kicks - Successful turning kicks to the body shall be awarded two points in all Junior sparring divisions.



## COMPETITION POOMSAE

### HOW DOES IT WORK?

The World Taekwondo Federation has developed an International Poomsae competition format that is used in the WTF World Poomsae Championships. The competition consists of Individual, Pairs and Team divisions. This competition will use the following Cut off System Method for the below **Black Belt** Divisions.

The **Method of Competition** starts with **Preliminaries**: After performing one (1) of the four (4) Poomsae in the 1<sup>st</sup> compulsory Poomsae predetermined by the tournament committee, the top 50 percent of participants will be qualified for the next round. **Semi-Final**: The top 50 percent of participants will be required to perform one (1) of the four (4) Poomsae in the 2<sup>nd</sup> compulsory Poomsae predetermined by the tournament committee. The top eight (8) of each category (individuals, pairs and teams) will be selected according to the results of their 2<sup>nd</sup> performance. **Final**: The top eight (8) of each category will be required to perform two (2) of the remaining three (3) Poomsae in the 2<sup>nd</sup> compulsory Poomsae predetermined by the tournament committee. The ranking of the top three (3) (Gold, Silver, Bronze medalist) of each category will be decided by the results of their performance

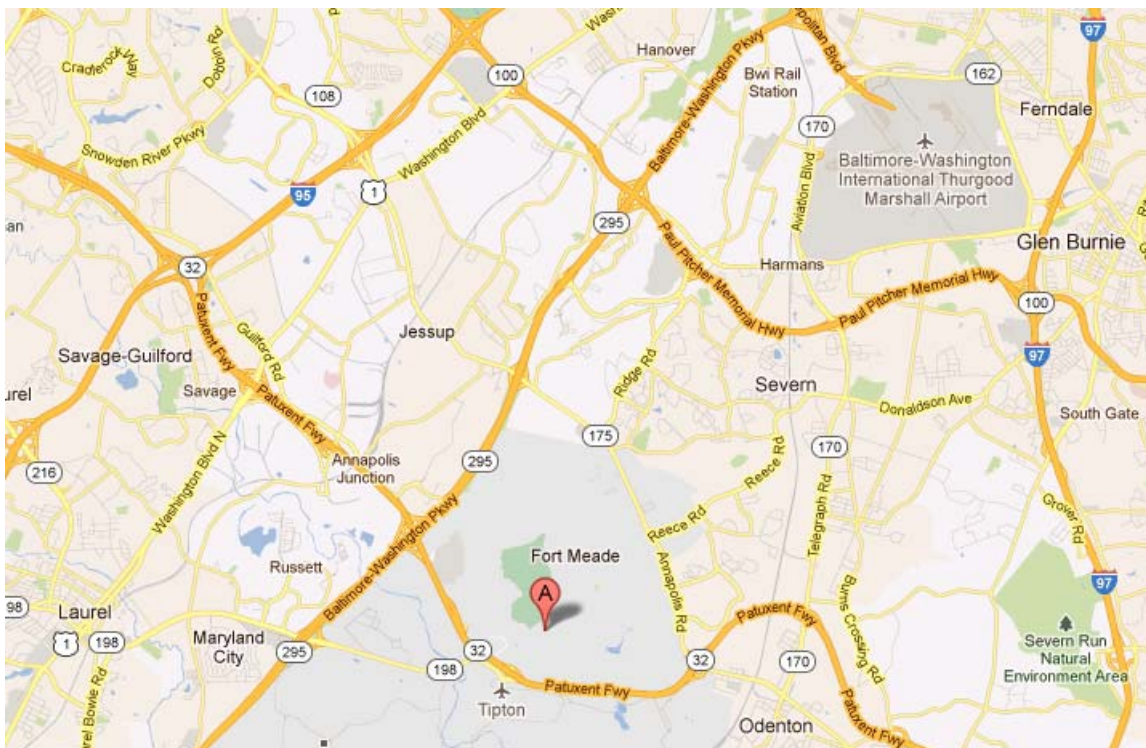
